Itinerary

Day 1 | Ho Chi Minh Arrival | Airport transfer

- Upon arrival at Ho Chi Minh, Tan Son Nhat International Airport, our driver will welcome you and take you to your hotel for check-in.
- Starting the beautiful journey of Heritage Vietnam and Cambodia 14 days.
- Depending on the time of arrival, enjoy the evening at leisure in your hotel or get ready to hit the ground running and dive into Vietnam's vibrant city.
- Ho Chi Minh city tour half day is available if required.

Inclusions: Private airport transfer.



Day 2 | Ho Chi Minh City Tour | Explore Cu Chi Tunnels Half Day



- Take the morning trip to Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace. Continue seeing the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times such as the Notre Dame Cathedral, and the historic Central Post Office. Followed by the remarkable site of the War Remnants Museum the museum has a vast display of both the Indochina wars.
- Depart for the Cu Chi tunnel, the trip will take approximately one and a half hours of bus driving.
- Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have a short introduction followed by an introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the hard conditions of wartime.
- Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems, including specially constructed living areas with kitchens, and bedrooms alongside other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are so many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security during the war.
- Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla's food during the war) will be served.
- Break time for relaxation or someone who wants to try a real shooting gun.
- Back to Ho Chi Minh at 15:00.

Day 3 | Fly to Danang | Hoi An Ancient Town



- Private transfer to Ho Chi Minh, Tan Son Nhat airport, and take a short flight to Danang. Then, transfer to Hoi An and check in at the hotel.
- 14:45 - 15:00- Our guide will meet you at our hotel in Hoi An Center and start the Hoi An City Tour.
- Start walking to the Hoi An Old Town- Go to the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, a colorful mélange of bright gates, dragon statues, and elaborate rooftops. Get an introduction to ancestor worship while visiting the family altar and watching local devotees making offerings. You will see remarkably well-preserved old houses Phung Hung Ancient House or Tan Ky Ancient House - That have withstood 200 years of weather and war. Learn about the prosperous merchants who used to live in these homes, trading with buyers from all around the world.
- Make a stop at the Japanese Bridge. The bridge spans a small waterway and was constructed more than 400 years ago to connect the Japanese community with the Chinese who lived on the other side of the water. Admire the carvings and paintings inside the bridge, learning about their symbolism and cultural significance.
- Additionally, visit some of Hoi An's well-known handicraft shops and artwork galleries. Discover smaller laneways and local neighborhoods gaining a better appreciation of Hoi An's endless charm.

Day 4 | My Son Sanctuary Half Day Trip



- 7:30-8:00: Our guide picks you up at your hotel and departs to My Son Sanctuary - The World Cultural Heritage.
- Arrive at My Son and we'll have 2 hours to discover the site by walking through the landscape, learning histories with our local English-speaking guide, and enjoying the Champa's traditional performances.
- Move to a local house to learn how to make rice paper, you will enjoy your hand-making product later.
- Have lunch at a local house. relax with cold herbal tea and fresh air.
- Take a boat trip to Hoi An with the nice and cool breeze onboard, and beautiful scenery on the biggest river in Central Vietnam named Thu Bon River.
- 14:00: Arrive in Hoi An, we will drop you off at your hotel.

Day 5 | Transfer to Hue City

- Join-in a luxury minivan for driving to Hue, a charming ancient town with a rich heritage that still maintains its unique character history. Our journey is through Hai Van Pass where the climate is different between the North and the South of Vietnam and Lang Co's fantastic sandy beaches.
- Upon arrival, check in hotel.
- Optional need to book in advance: Hue Street food tour.

Inclusions: Private transfer.

Day 6 | Historical Hue



- 08:00: Our Car and your guide will pick you up at your hotel.
- Take a dragon boat to the first place, Thien Mu Pagoda (Heaven Fairy Lady Pagoda) - the oldest pagoda in Hue city. The 30-minute boat drive to the pagoda in the morning will be a great start for the journey. Fresh air from Perfume River will make you very comfortable.
- 9.30 am: Visit the Citadel - Imperial city is the home of Vietnam's last royal dynasty - the Nguyen Dynasty.
- After the Citadel, our car will take you to Dong Ba market - the busiest market in Hue with various kinds of

foods and goods. Here you can see how the local people buy and sell things. This is also a chance for you to buy souvenirs for your friends and family.

- Lunch at a local restaurant.
- Visit Minh Mang Tomb - considered as the most majestic of all the Royal Tombs. Renowned for its architecture, which harmoniously blends into the natural surroundings.

Day 7 | Fly to Hanoi City



- Transfer to Hue Airport, and take a short flight to Hanoi, Noi Bai Airport.
- Upon arrival, our driver will welcome you and take you to your hotel for check-in.
- Cap off the day with a free walk through the Old Quarter, also known as the 36 streets, this bustling area of narrow streets is home to thousands of small businesses and shopkeepers
- Optional need to book in advance: water puppet shows. Duration: 1 hour.

Day 8 | Charming Hanoi



- You will visit Tran Quoc Pagoda, Ho Chi Minh complex, including Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, House on stilts, the President Palace, and One Pillar Pagoda.
- Afterward, visit the Temple of Literature, the first college of Vietnam, and the place dedicated to Confucius.
- Lunch at a local restaurant.
- Take a Cyclo (Rickshaw) tour through the Old Quarter, also known as the 36 streets, this bustling area of narrow streets is home to thousands of small businesses and shopkeepers.

Day 9 | Amazing Ninh Binh



- 08: 00 AM, we will start to explore the peaceful Ninh Binh.
- Arrive in Ninh Binh to start your visit to Mua Cave and hike to the top of Dragon Mountain to see a panorama view of Ninh Binh.
- Board the sampan boats in the famous Tam Coc dock to drift down villages, mountains, and lush rice fields. Passing through 3 caves amid dramatic nature jungle-clad Lime-Stones mountains raised majestically out of floods.
- start to explore the rural villages, valleys, and limestone mountains by bicycle, where you can take pictures of amazing scenery and landscape.
- Visiting Bich Dong, one of the most ancient pagodas in the North. The tour guide will give you an introduction to Vietnam's history and Buddhist.

Day 10 | Wonderful Ha Long Bay



- You will be picked up from your hotel and transferred to Halong Bay (3hrs).
- Embark cruise, having lunch on board.
- Explore Sung Sot Cave, where you can explore its beauty.
- Swimming at Titop Island or conquer the Peak with panorama views.
- A sunset party on the sundeck would be served, where you can enjoy some refreshing drinks and tasty bites while taking in the breathtaking view.

Day 11 | Ha Long | Return to Hanoi



- Greeting the dawn of the sea on the sundeck, exercise Tai Chi in the fresh air of Halong Bay.
- Kayaking around Drum Cave
- Visit Ba Hang fishing village, Dog Islet, and more exciting sceneries of the Bay.
- Enjoy a brunch on board.
- Disembark cruise and head back to Hanoi.

Day 12 | Fly to Siem Reap

- Check out your hotel, transfer to Hanoi – Noi Bai airport, and take a short flight to Siem Reap.
- Upon arrival, meet your driver for a transfer to your hotel for check-in.
- Recharge energy to explore the Kingdom of Wonder the next day.

Day 13 | Angkor Highligh



- Explore Angkor's ancient wonders with a new group of friends! The first stop is the Angkor Thom complex. Within these magnificent walls, you'll discover the fascinating beauty of Bayon and the world-famous Ta Prohm (Tomb Raider) Temple.
- Following that, satiate your hunger at one of the many local restaurants within the Angkor Complex with some delicious Cambodian cuisine!
- Your final two stops will be at the massive and gorgeous Angkor Wat, followed by a stunning sunset view from the top of Phnom Bakheng. The temples on this tour are among the largest in the Angkor Complex, and Phnom Bakheng has a 300-person limit at the peak, so we keep the temple count low to ensure enough time at each spectacular stop!
- We'll return to town once the sun has set (around 6:30 PM).

Day 13 | Floating Village | Siem Reap Departure



- Begin the tour by visiting a local market to see villagers selling their home-grown vegetables or a local pagoda to learn about religion.
- Then, take a tour of the astounding floating villages known as stilt-houses, which stand between 8 and 10 meters high, school, farm, and even the hospital, where people have bravely adapted to some of the most unimaginable conditions, all while smiling.
- From the comfort of our boat trip, take in the beautiful atmosphere of this one-of-a-kind village.
- Back to the hotel, your memorable Heritage Vietnam and Cambodia 14 Days will be done.
