Itinerary

Day 1 | Ho Chi Minh Arrival | Airport transfer

- Upon arrival at Ho Chi Minh, Tan Son Nhat International Airport, our driver will welcome you and take you to your hotel for check-in.
- Starting the beautiful journey of Majestic Vietnam 15 days from Ho Chi Minh.
- Depending on the time of arrival, enjoy the evening at leisure in your hotel or get ready to hit the ground running and dive into Vietnam's vibrant city.
- Optional need to book in advance: Street food tour on Scooter.

Day 2 | Ho Chi Minh City Tour | Explore Cu Chi Tunnels Half Day





- Take the morning trip to Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace. Continue seeing
 the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times such as the Notre Dame Cathedral, and the historic
 Central Post Office. Followed by the remarkable site of the War Remnants Museum the museum has a
 vast display of both the Indochina wars.
- Depart for the Cu Chi tunnel, the trip will take approximately one and a half hours of bus driving.
- Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have a short introduction followed by an introductory
 video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the hard conditions of
 wartime.
- Then, spend your time exploring the remaining area and tunnel systems, including specially constructed living areas with kitchens, and bedrooms alongside other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs.
 Besides, there are so many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security during the war.
- Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla's food during the war) will be served.
- Break time for relaxation or someone who wants to try a real shooting gun.
- Back to Ho Chi Minh at 15:00.

Day 3: Mekong Delta | My Tho | Ben Tre



- Leaving the hustle and bustle of Ho Chi Minh City and starting your trip to depart for My Tho, the town lies on the left side of the Mekong River. Upon arrival, visit Vinh Trang Pagoda which dates to the late 19th century. Afterward, boarding the sampan and cruising down the river around the four beautiful islands known as Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise Islands.
- Stop over at Unicorn Island, walk around the country lane, and see orchards, enjoy tropical fruits, and folk song music which is performed by the local people. Visit the fruit plantation.
- Ride a hand-rowed sampan through the Thoi Son canal and treat yourself to the beauty of the countryside, visit the family business, visit the honey-bee farm, and enjoy a honey tea and coconut candy workshop.
- Have lunch at a local restaurant.
- In the afternoon, time to cycle around Tan Thach village, and meet the local villagers to experience the local daily life in the Mekong Delta. Hammock relaxing and enjoying cool breeze for those who can't join the cycling trip. Return to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 4 | Fly to Danang | Hoian Ancient Town



- Private transfer to Ho Chi Minh, Tan Son Nhat airport, and take a short flight to Danang. Then, transfer to Hoian and check in at the hotel.
- 14:45 15:00- Our guide will meet you at our hotel in Hoian Center and start the Hoian City Tour.
- Start walking to the Hoian Old Town- Go to the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, a colorful mélange of bright gates, dragon statues, and elaborate rooftops. Get an introduction to ancestor worship while visiting the family altar and watching local devotees making offerings. You will see remarkably well-preserved old houses Phung Hung Ancient House or Tan Ky Ancient House - That have withstood 200 years of weather and war. Learn about the prosperous merchants who used to live in these homes, trading with buyers from all around the world.
- Make a stop at the Japanese Bridge. The bridge spans a small waterway and was constructed more than 400 years ago to connect the Japanese community with the Chinese who lived on the other side of the water. Admire the carvings and paintings inside the bridge, learning about their symbolism and cultural significance.
- Additionally, visit some of Hoi An's well-known handicraft shops and artwork galleries. Discover smaller laneways and local neighborhoods gaining a better appreciation of Hoi An's endless charm.
